Adults can stay at the school – if they desire hotel accommodations they should add \$250 to the tour costs. Airline Taxes and fuel surcharge costs of approx \$400 have to be added to all prices.

These fees are set by airlines and governments and can change prior to ticketing, Travel and Play cannot control these costs.

Please note these prices are based on current available airfares and exchange rates. The exact price will be guaranteed at the time of booking when all space is confirmed and a deposit of \$300 per person is received.

Match Program –

Frequently Asked Questions:

What is the purpose of the trip?

The trips are designed to educate, to develop, to improve and to open the eyes of our players to the world of soccer and indeed, the world itself.

Who organizes the trip?

The trip is organized by Travel and Play, their owner Barry Walmsley has worked closely with Sean Bubb, Rob Ferguson and other LSC coaches to design a tour for the Lonestar SC players and families.

What expectations are there for players?

Lonestar players will be expected to demonstrate exemplary behavior and professionalism while on the trip. Players will be representing themselves, their families, their team and their club across international boundaries and we will accept nothing less than well mannered, well behaved, polite, hard working young people on this trip.

What documents are players required to have?

All players are required to have a Passport in order to travel (no exceptions). In addition, there will be a code of conduct and liability/medical waiver to be signed by both the player and parent.

How do we pay for the trip?

Total Tour Cost (Boys England) = \$2,225.00 (plus airline taxes approx \$400)

Total Tour Cost (Girls Germany) = \$2,215.00 (plus airline taxes approx \$370)

Who travels with the team?

A minimum of one Lonestar Coach per two teams, club appointed parent chaperones, Travel and Play Tour Guides.

Can parents travel with the team?

Yes, unlike our Mexico trip of the past, parents are allowed to come on this trip and be a part of the experience. However, there will be no opportunities to take you child away from the Lonestar trip itinerary.

Transportation?

Once at the departure airport Travel and Play will organize all transportation until arrival back at the same airport. Parents will be responsible for getting their son/daughter to and from the departure airport. Charter buses will be used and will stay with the group the entire trip once in Europe.

How long is the trip?

The trip is approximately 16 to 20 hours each way including any layovers needed.

What is the accommodation information?



Actual accommodation information and contact numbers will be provided closer to the time, outlines of both trips can be found in the Booking Forms for the respective trips.

How many players in a room and who decides roommates?

Girls – 3 Players per room

Boys – 1 or 2 Players per room

Coaches will assign rooming lists in coordination with Chaperones.

What happens to passports and documents?

Chaperones will keep all documents once through the Passport Control on arrival in Europe.

Will my child have to buy his meals?

Most meals are included in price of trip; however spending money for lunches/snacks/souvenirs is acceptable. Last year all meals were served as a group/buffet style.

How much spending money should he bring?

It is recommended no more than \$300 cash be sent per player. Money will be used for lunches, extra snacks, drinks and souvenirs.

What happens if my son gets sick?

We hope to be traveling with Physicians that will help advise on any illness issues, regardless, the levels of medical care available in both England and Germany are comparable with those here in the US. In all places Travel and Play staff are aware of Hospital/Doctor Locations

Will they have fresh water to drink?

Tap water is perfectly safe to drink in both England and Germany. We recommend every player bring a water bottle.

Will the players be covered by my insurance?

All personal family insurance should be verified before departure as to extent of coverage. STYSA liability insurance is in effect. Travel Insurance is available and recommended

Will there be an itinerary for each day?

Yes a very accurate schedule of events will be handed out as we get closer to departure. Players will have training sessions, games, stadium tours, shopping opportunities, live professional games, meetings, chalk board sessions, specific meal times and set curfews. A basic outline, day by day is available and has been handed out to you in this meeting.

What happens during down time?

There will be very limited, if any, actual down time.

Can we call our kids?

Rooms may be set up to receive calls, depending upon the accommodation. Cell phones with international calling capabilities may be used but check with your individual provider. If you can not reach your player, the Chaperone will be main point of contact for parents, not coaches.
